3. JAZZ LECTURE

In June 2007, **Dr. Gene Aitken** received the United States top jazz education honor by being awarded the 2007 Jazz Educator of the Year by DownBeat magazine. During a long time, he has been Director of Jazz Studies at the University of Northen Colorado, one of the most well known jazz education programs. Dr Gene Aitken worked worldwide as an educator, producer, musician. His CV is so long and various that it is a great opportunity for us to welcome him for this lecture.
